

WASTE WATER DEPARTMENT:

Nicholas Dezelan requested approval of the revised Facilities Maintenance job description. Locke moved to approve, duly seconded by McClarnon. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Nicholas Dezelan requested approval of the quote from Xylem for the repair of Raw Sewage Pump #1 with a cost of \$32,860.08. The Mayor had declared this an emergency repair in order to get the parts on order, and had previously approved the repairs of the pump. Discussion was had. McClarnon moved to approve, duly seconded by Shelby. Motion carried *viva voce*.

FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Deputy Chief Jason Horning requested approval of the Intercept Agreement with Raleigh Fire Department and Shirley Fire Department. McClarnon moved to approve, duly seconded by Locke. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Deputy Chief Jason Horning requested approval for the promotion of Andrew Heller to Senior Firefighter at a bi-weekly amount of \$2,624.90 plus an annual Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) stipend of \$1,000.00, effective January 7th. Shelby moved to approve, duly seconded by Locke. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Rolly has been with the City for (29) twenty-nine years, (16) sixteen years with the Clerk-Treasurer's office and (13) thirteen years currently with the Greenfield Fire Department. Deputy Chief Jason Horning oversaw the badge pinning of Lieutenant Corey Breese, Lieutenant Jeff Dixon and Lieutenant AJ Lewman requesting those present for the ceremony to come forward. They were warmly greeted by all present.
