Recycling Service Agreement (page 2 of 2)

Conditions

Packaging: All lamps and batteries must be separated according to type, packaged-enclosed and sealed to EPA & USDOT regulations and standards. Lamps must not be wet, taped or banded together nor mixed with debris. All battery terminals must be fully insulated per USDOT standards.

Lighting Resources will provide or arrange for: transportation, documentation, and waste reduction/recycling/disposal of intact and crushed lamps, lighting ballasts, batteries, waste electronics, and mercury devices. Transportation pricing valid based on service requests submitted within the time frame specified on previous page. Priority service is available and will be quoted on a per job basis. Title to all materials will pass to Lighting Resources when the materials enter the possession of a Lighting Resources representative. All materials treated by Lighting Resources recycling centers will be processed in accordance with EPA regulations as well as all applicable regulatory permitting.

Acceptable Wastes: The following wastes are accepted by Lighting Resources for treatment and/or trans-shipment to a permitted treatment facility: intact and crushed lamps, lighting ballasts, batteries, waste electronics, mercury devices, and automotive airbags. Lighting Resources is prohibited from receiving and will refuse all radioactive wastes, biological wastes, municipal wastes, flammable wastes, explosive wastes, and pyrophoric wastes. Additional fees may apply for wastes mixed with debris. Tritium Exit signs and smoke detectors are managed by our EZ on the Earth mail-back program. Call 855-327-8455 for more information.

Shipping Requirements: All pricing is valid provided that all USDOT and Lighting Resources shipping and packing requirements are met. Lamps must be packed in structurally sound, sealed containers that are capable of containing any breakage while in transit. Hazardous wastes must be in UN approved / rated shipping containers. Container lids must be secured to containers. Appropriate labeling must be applied to all containers prior to pick-up. All containers of Non-PCB ballast must be clearly marked as "Non-PCB". Any ballasts not readily identifiable as Non-PCB will be treated as PCB. Lighting Resources will provide proper shipping papers as long as all information is supplied by the generator or their representative. Lighting Resources cannot be held liable in the event that incorrect or insufficient information is supplied. Lighting Resources reserves the right to refuse loads that are improperly prepared for shipment. A fee of **\$150.00** for each location will apply if we are unable to accept materials at the scheduled time of service.

Return/Rejection Policy: Permitting requires that Lighting Resources expedite the return of rejected materials. Lighting Resources will notify the generator if materials have been identified as unacceptable. All rejected materials will be returned at the generator's expense.

Supplies: All supplies provided to the customer are the exclusive property of Lighting Resources, LLC. Replacement fees will apply for any supplies that are lost, stolen, damaged, or otherwise returned in an unacceptable condition. The customer is responsible for damages to trailers and storage units provided by Lighting Resources while in the customer's possession.

Liability: Federal regulation does not allow Lighting Resources to absolve a generator's liability. It is the generator's responsibility to ensure all applicable federal, state, and local requirements are met. Lighting Resources does not provide legal advice or opinion with regard to regulatory compliance.

Transportation: Zone rates are based on the distance from any of LRL's branches and service centers. Zone rates are in 50 mile radius of a branch location up to 250 miles radius (day trip)
