APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Councilman Grass moved to approve the October 13, 2010 meeting minutes as presented and circulated, seconded by Councilman McClarnon. Motion carried *viva voce*.

REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS:

OLD BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2010-15 an Ordinance for Appropriations and Tax Rate 14 Parts on second reading as introduced by City Attorney, Morelock. Councilman Horning made a motion to pass Ordinance 2010-15 on second reading. Councilman McClarnon seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Ordinance 2010-15 an Ordinance for Appropriations and Tax Rate including 14 Parts on third and final reading as introduced by City Attorney, Morelock. Councilman Davis made a motion to pass Ordinance 2010-15 on third reading. Councilman Horning seconded the motion. Council President, Evans called for a roll call vote by Chief Deputy Shuler. NEW BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2010-16 an Ordinance Authorizing Additional Appropriations. This for additional appropriations for the three funds listed for additional appropriations to the budget funds for expenditures due to the increase in revenue for those funds as noted and will be forwarded to the Department of Local Government Finance for their review and approval. Councilman Grass made a motion to approve Ordinance 2010-16 on first reading. Councilman Horning seconded the motion. Motion Carried.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:

Councilman Pendlum expressed concern on unsolicited advertising being distributed to homeowners in his neighborhood. It was recommended Councilman Pendlum call the Star to request them to stop delivering the advertisement to his address.

Mayor DeReamer complimented the Department Head and employees for the great job they did with the repairs/cleanup from the recent storm.

Councilman Davis commended the Mayor on completion of a sidewalk on Park Avenue.
