APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Councilman McClarnon moved to approve the January 27, 2010 meeting minutes of the Common Council as presented, seconded by Councilman Grass. Motion carried *viva voce*.

REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS, AND COMMISSIONS:

OLD BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2010-3 an Ordinance to Create an Economic Development Income Tax Fund; was introduced by title only on second reading. Councilman Grass moved to approve on second reading as presented, seconded by Councilman McClarnon. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Ordinance 2010-3 an Ordinance to Create an Economic Development Income Tax Fund; was again read by title only on third and final reading by Attorney, Morelock. Councilman Pendlum moved to approve on third reading as presented, seconded by Councilman McClarnon. Council President, Evans called for a roll call vote. AYES: Councilman Horning, McClarnon, Pendlum, Davis, Evans, and Grass. NAYES: None. Council President, Evans declared Ordinance 2010-3 approved with a 6 to 0 vote

NEW BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2010-4 an Ordinance Regarding Payment In Lieu of Taxes; Councilman Davis moved to have introduced by title only on first reading, seconded by Councilman McClarnon. Motion carried. City Attorney, Morelock introduced Ordinance 2010-4 by reading title only for first reading. Councilman Horning moved to approve on first reading as presented, seconded by Councilman McClarnon. Motion carried *viva voce*.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:

Councilman Evans mentioned article in local paper about the proposed Payment In Lieu of Taxes Ordinance, which the paper called a bail out for the city. He wanted the public to know that the funds being used were from cash reserves and would not necessitate a rate increase in the near future. He stated that indeed we were in tuff times and Council was trying to what is best for the citizens of Greenfield. Councilman McClarnon wanted

to thank Mayor DeReamer for the quick response to putting this ordinance together and for working with the Common Council in regards to this matter.
