

GREENFIELD 3 on 3 ROUND BALL CLASSIC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Participate in the ***Greenfield 3 on 3 Round Ball Classic*** on May 21 at the Riley Park Basketball Courts. Games start at 9 AM sharp (lunch break 12-12:30 PM). There is a minimum of 8 teams and a maximum of 16 teams for registration. Each team must have 3 to 5 players on its roster. Rosters are final at the time of registration. The schedule will be in a double elimination tournament format. Games are played half-court style. First team to 20 points (by 1's and 2's) wins each game. Teams keep their own score and call their own fouls/violations. Participant cost benefit is \$50 per team. Prizes are awarded to tournament winner and runner up.

WHO: Adults ages 16 & Up (16-17 yr olds need parent signature w/ staff)

*Each team must fill out a Roster/Waiver form at the time of registration

*Minimum 8 teams, Maximum 16 teams

WHAT: *Greenfield 3 on 3 Round Ball Classic Basketball Tournament*

*(half-court - 3 on 3 style games)-(teams keep score & call fouls/violations)

WHERE: Riley Park Basketball Courts (4 half courts)

WHEN: Saturday May 21, 2011 – 9:00 AM start time

*Each team needs to check in before games begin-please read rules

*(June 4, 2011 is scheduled rainout makeup date)

PROGRAM COST BENEFIT: \$50 per team, no refunds after deadline

*(Over half of the price when compared to other similar tournaments!)

REGISTRATION: Begins April 4 and ends May 13 at 4:00 PM

***Teams are responsible for reading, knowing and adhering to all tournament rules/regulations. Each team should bring a regulation size, outdoor basketball to use for the games (captains choose).**



In signing this document, the participant specifically acknowledges that there are certain risks inherent to participant in Greenfield Parks and Recreation Program and use of the park facilities and said participant specially assumes risks.

Any individual signing as parent or guardian of a minor participant does hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Board and City of Greenfield and its agents or employees from all damages or cots, including fees.

GREENFIELD 3 on 3 ROUND BALL CLASSIC RULES & REGULATIONS**

GREENFIELD 3 ON 3 ROUND BALL CLASSIC

The following rules have been designed to ensure fair play for all participants. Each player is expected to understand these rules prior to participation in the tournament. Any questions concerning these rules should be directed to the Greenfield Parks Department before the play of any games.

REGISTRATION

All Participants are required to print on and sign the roster/waiver form before participating in league play and pay for league fees. A player's name, age, and telephone number will be required during league sign in. All participants must be at least 18 years of age. Anyone 16 or 17 must have a parent or guardian sing a special waiver form of liability.

TEAM CAPTAIN RESPONSIBILITY

It is the Team Captain's responsibility to be the primary link between league management and the team and his duty to obtain pertinent tournament information and maintain control over team members in all circumstances including and disputes on or off the court.

PRIOR TO THE GAME

Each team must have three to five players on its roster who have registered their team by the predetermined entry deadline. Any additions/changes to any roster must be approved by Greenfield Parks Staff prior to the start of a team's first game of the event. No substitutions are allowed one a team's roster of five players has been filled without prior written consent of the Greenfield Parks Staff. A player is only allowed to participate for only one team for the duration of the tournament without the prior written consent of the Greenfield Parks Staff. Government issued picture identification is required for all participants (EX: driver's license, state id, etc.).

All players must sign the score sheet before each game and designate the team's captain/spokesperson. The team captain will represent his/her team as a spokesperson at all times. No exceptions.

All games must start with three players on each team, unless the team with three players agrees to allow the opposing team to play with only two players.

If the team with at least three players does not allow the opposing team to play with two players, or the opposing team has zero or one player, that team will forfeit the game.

ROSTERS WILL BE FINAL AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION. NO EXCEPTIONS.

**TEAMS NOT MEETING ROSTER REQUIRMENTS AT ANY GAME TIME WILL
FORFEIT GAME.**

Team captains will decide which team will shoot for the first possession. Each team may bring a regulation size basketball-team captains agree upon which ball to use before the start of the game. NO ball switching after the game starts unless there is a “maintenance” issue.

STARTING PLAY

The ball must be thrown (not dribbled) in from the out of bounds area.

AFTER THE GAME

The captain of the winning team will report the score to the Greenfield Parks Staff. Each team must check the Master Schedule for future scheduling information.

GAME PLAY

Length of Games: First team to score 20 points wins the game (1 point baskets & 2 point behind the arc baskets). No make it - take it. The ball changes possession after each scored basket. Games will start at posted schedule times (unless requested in a special circumstance by Greenfield Parks Staff). No exceptions. Any team not officially ready to start on time will forfeit the game in question. Be ready and be on time!

Rule Interpretation: Players call their own fouls, violations and keep their own score. The player fouled is responsible for making the call. Any disputes of any kind between the teams that cannot be resolved before the start of the next scheduled game (unless a dispute time limit is issued by Greenfield Parks Staff) will result in both teams forfeiting the game. All participants are expected to utilize proper sportsmanship during the entire duration of the tournament (on and off the court).

Time Outs: No time outs are permitted unless there is an emergency situation.

Taking it Back: When in play, the ball must be “taken back” on each change of possession. “Taking it back” means BOTH feet must be behind the two-point arc.

Resuming Play: The ball must be thrown in (not dribbled) in from the out of bounds area after the ball has changed possession on an out of bounds play.

Interference: In the case of an interference situation (ball rolls on court, player from another court, etc.), play would stop and the offensive team would check up the ball at the top of the key with the defensive team.

Scoring: Baskets made from the inside of the arc count for one point. Baskets made when the shooter has BOTH feet behind the arc count two points. No dunking. This may result in forfeiture of game(s).

Free Throws: Free throws count as one point. When fouled in the act of shooting, free throws are awarded to the fouled shooter only when the basket was not made. All free throws are dead balls. Regardless of whether the free throw(s) are made, the opposing

team checks the ball at the top of the key. All other players will remain behind the two point arc while the free throw attempt is being made.

Fouls: Any time a basket is MADE and a foul is called:

- The basket counts
- Defending team receives the ball

Player Conduct: All participants and their spectators are expected to utilize proper sportsmanship at all times (on or off the court). Continuous or blatant misconduct will result in team forfeiture and team dismissal from the tournament. It may or may not be intentional. Anything involving violent contact such as striking, kneeling, etc. will not be tolerated.

THERE IS ABSOLUTLY NO FIGHTING! Any player who fights will be suspended from the tournament and the **local authorities will be contacted.**

A physical or verbal threat to any league official or fighting (fighting constitutes any motion or intent of, directed by one player towards another person using any part of one's body to commit harm) will result in at least an immediate suspension from the tournament.

When a player is suspended or ejected from the/a tournament/game, that person is NOT permitted to be in the playing area (or park) for the duration of the tournament. If that player does not vacate the premises in a timely manner or attempts to re-enter the playing area, officials/staff can award the opposing team with a win via forfeit. Any player or team captain ejected from a game will not be allowed to participate in the next league game. **Local authorities will be contacted if needed.**

No smoking is allowed

No intoxicating beverages will be permitted, on/or the surrounding area before, during, or after tournament games. Any player seen drinking or suspected of being intoxicated in any way directly before or during a game will be ejected.

Only game players, managers, scorekeepers, tournament staff, and officials are allowed on the benches and playing area.

Any matter not covered by the Parks and Recreation Department, shall be left to Parks Staff.

Any undue delay of game may result in forfeiture of game by said team. It is the responsibility of the team captain to see that their team does not waste time going on or leaving the playing area.

NOTE: There will be no refund given for the suspension and/or dismissals from the league.

Any game will be stopped if Parks Staff deems that the game is out of control, or the team captain is ineffective to control his/her team. Parks Staff decisions are final.

PROFANITY OF A STRONG, VULGAR NATURE, AND/OR DIRECTED TOWARD OTHERS; WITH NEGATIVE INTENT, IS PROHIBITED AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED! This includes any unnecessary verbal abuse while on City property during any portion of the Basketball League with negative intent, directed toward a player, coach, manager, Staff Member, Official, spectator, and patron of the facility. Any ruling concerning this area is left up to game Official's interpretation, perception, and discretion. All rulings made by Parks Staff are final.

The ball is out of bounds if it:

- Passes over the top edge of the backboard or touches the back side of the backboard
- Touches the arms attached to the back of the backboard

The ball remains in play if the ball:

- Touches the bottom edge of the backboard
- Touches one of the side edges of the backboard
- Touches the top edge of the backboard but does not pass over the top edge of the backboard

Tournament Administration:

Any discussion of any kind will be discussed only with the team spokesperson. Everything is final after the game has been completed.

Use of illegal players:

The players listed on the roster at the time an entry form is submitted are the only players eligible without the consent of Greenfield Parks Staff. Parks Staff reserve the right to request identification from players at any time during the tournament. All participants are required to bring picture identification to the tournament. Each player must be able to present a photo ID at every game. Rosters may be checked periodically. A team may ask for a roster to be checked before the game starts. After the game begins, challenges are not permitted.

Any team playing with an ineligible player, or players, will automatically forfeit the game in which the infraction(s) occurred. EXAMPLE: age, illegal player, etc.

False Information:

Information provided to Greenfield Parks on your entry form is the basis for tournament breakdown. Any false information is grounds for disqualification.

Unnecessary vulgarity or abusive conduct:

Good sportsmanship is expected. A Greenfield Parks Staff Member may assist in any capacity that they deem necessary.

Sportsmanship Deposit:

Each team is required to submit a \$50 sportsmanship deposit. Upon successful sportsmanship completion of the tournament, each team will be able to have their deposit returned the next business day at the Parks Administration Office. The deposit will be kept if Greenfield Parks Staff deems it necessary to do so. All Greenfield Parks Department Staff decisions are final and without questions. Anyone participating in this tournament agrees to this rule section and all other rules/regulations.

GENERAL RULES

No jewelry is allowed.

Any schedule changes will not be made after the schedule is printed, unless otherwise decided upon by the League. Games will not be rescheduled. Both teams must present their starting line-up to the Park Staff no less than 5 minutes before game time to avoid penalties.

No game shall be arbitrarily postponed, except in cases of extreme emergency as approved by Parks Staff or whereby the playing surface shall be considered unfit for play. Parks Staff shall determine the fitness of the playing area, and the decision shall be final.

No refunds will be given for any reason after the entry deadline!

TEAM TOURNAMENT PLACEMENT

Tournament placement will be determined with team names being drawn “out of a hat”.


PARKS RULES

Greenfield 3 on 3 Round Ball Classic Players Code of Conduct

I will understand that it is the responsibility of myself and my team to have enough players show to each game-If my team does not have enough players when a Staff Member (Staff Member(s) keep official game time with their own time keeping device-no exceptions) calls for the official start of the game, it is our own fault and not the fault of the Staff Member, Parks Department or anyone else that has anything to do with the Tournament-I have received and read the Players Code of Conduct and understand the expectations of the City of Greenfield Parks and Recreation Department and agree to comply at all times with no exceptions

Terms and conditions of this Tournament (if deemed necessary) may be changed, with or without cause, and with or without notice, at any time by the Greenfield Parks Department.
