



Greenfield Wastewater Project Notification

The City of Greenfield Wastewater Utility is planning a sanitary sewer rehabilitation project for McClellan residents on Maple Street to Oak Street. This project is scheduled to begin on or after August 24, 2020 and be completed by October 2, 2020.

The rehabilitation work will be done in the sanitary easement between McClellan Road and Grandison Road. The purpose of this project is to replace the existing clay sanitary sewer pipe with SDR35 PVC pipe. The laterals from homes will be replaced from the main sewer line to your property line. The existing brick built manhole structures will also be replaced with pre-cast concrete structures. Site restoration will be completed once the project is complete.

We appreciate your patience and apologize for any inconvenience during the course of this project. It is our goal to complete this project in a timely manner. However, the Wastewater Utility crews may need to break off from the project to take care of any emergency issues that may arise during the course of the project.
