This Amendment 1 ("Amendment") made and entered by and between the State of Indiana through the Indiana Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as "INDOT") and the Greenfield Police Department, Hancock County, Indiana (hereinafter referred to as the Law Enforcement Agency "LEA") (collectively referred to as the "PARTIES") through their duly authorized and undersigned officials, is executed pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein and shall be effective as of the date of approval by the Office of the Indiana Attorney General. In consideration of those mutual undertakings and covenants, the PARTIES agree as follows:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2021, the PARTIES entered into an Agreement under EDS #A249-21-ON210039 to install law enforcement equipment ("LEE"), within state-owned or controlled right-of-way in Hancock County, Indiana (hereinafter referred to as the "Original Agreement") in the interest of public safety; and

WHEREAS, the LEA wishes to install additional LEE within state-owned or controlled right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the PARTIES wish to modify the Original Agreement to include the additional locations for the LEE; and

WHEREAS, the LEA has agreed to pay all costs associated with the installation of the additional LEE; and

WHEREAS, the LEA has agreed to maintain the additional LEE after the installation, to the satisfaction of INDOT, and to pay for all costs associated with future maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the PARTIES wish to substitute **Exhibit A-1**, which depicts all LEE locations, for **Exhibit A** to the Original Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and the mutually dependent covenants contained herein, the PARTIES agree as follows:

- 1. Exhibit A of the Original Agreement is deleted in its entirety and is hereby substituted with Exhibit A-1.
- 2. Section 2.5.2. is deleted in its entirety and is substituted with the following:
 - 2.5.2. The LEA shall ensure that the installation and location of the LEE and areas of INDOT ROW used for the LEE be in substantial conformity with Exhibit A-1 (attached and fully incorporated herein by reference). INDOT shall have the right to terminate this Agreement and order removal of the LEE, if, in INDOT's sole discretion, it is determined that the location of the LEE substantially deviates from that depicted in Exhibit A-1, if the LEE equipment substantially deviates from the plans shown in Exhibit B (attached, and fully incorporated herein by reference), or, subject to the notification provisions contained herein.
- 3. Section 2.5.9. is deleted in its entirety and is substituted with the following:
 - 2.5.9. The LEA may request in writing that locations within state-owned or controlled right of way be added to or removed from Exhibit A-1. A formal amendment to this Agreement will be required before a change in the location is effective.
- 4. Section 2.5.12. is deleted in its entirety and is substituted with the following:
 - 2.5.12. Any use of the right-of-way permitted by this Agreement remains secondary to the interest of INDOT to use the right-of-way for highway or other transportation purposes. The LEA agrees that it shall promptly remove the LEE at its own expense, whether in part or in its entirety, if, in INDOT's sole discretion, the right-of-way or any portion thereof is required for future expansion, modification, or maintenance of any transportation or utility infrastructure or facility. The LEA understands and agrees that it shall not be entitled to any damages or any other compensation if INDOT requires complete or partial removal of the LEE for any reason.
- 5. Section 3.1. is deleted in its entirety and is substituted with the following:
 - 3.1. INDOT shall have approval authority for the LEA's design, construction, and maintenance plans and for any improvements located within INDOT ROW. Such review and approval shall be completed within a reasonable timeframe.
- 6. Section 4.31. is deleted in its entirety and is substituted with the following:
 - 4.31. <u>Notice to Parties</u>. Whenever any notice, statement or other communication is required under this Agreement, it shall be sent to the following addresses, unless otherwise specifically advised:

- 7. Section 4.25. is deleted in its entirety and is substituted with the following:
 - 4.25. <u>Insurance</u>. The LEA shall cause and require the contractors installing or maintaining the LEE at each location listed in <u>Exhibit A-1</u> to secure and keep in force during the term of any installation or maintenance activity occurring in INDOT right-of-way, the insurance coverages specified in the 2022 INDOT Standard Specifications.
- 8. All other matters previously agreed to and set forth in the Original Agreement and not affected by this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.


