THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 11th day of February 2025 by and between <u>The Peterson Company, LLC</u> ("Subdivider"), and the City of Greenfield, herein represented by the Board of Public Works and Safety.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Subdivider has completed off-site road re-construction for <u>Progress Park</u>, and has received approval and acceptance from the Board of Public Works and Safety for subdivision off-site improvements constructed herein; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Subdivision Control Ordinance, the Subdivider is required to maintain certain improvements for a period of three (3) years:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the Subdivider and the Board of Public Works and Safety that the Subdivider hereby agrees to keep all components of the following improvements related to the Huskies Property Subdivision in good condition, and will make such repairs to any effect in materials or workmanship as may develop or be discovered when called upon to do so by the Board of Public Works and Safety
