Re: Manhole Rehabilitation

Mayor and Board Members,

During routine inspections of our sanitary and stormwater collection systems, our maintenance crew discovered several manholes that are in need of rehabilitation. There is another manhole on US 40 and Broadway that also needs immediate attention in order to prevent further structural damage.

In total, we currently know of 12 manholes and 2 valve vaults that need to be repaired or lined. Culy Contracting has provided the attached proposal to complete this work. The total estimated cost for these repairs is \$20,800.00.

At this time, I am requesting that the Board approve the proposal as presented in the amount of \$20,800.00 and an additional \$ 20,000.00 as a not to exceed amount if any other structures are found to be in need of repair. In discussing this with the City Engineer, we will likely enter into a Professional Services Agreement in the following years in order to have repairs of this nature completed without having to get approval for each one. This will help satisfy part of our Preventative Maintenance program that will be required by the Agreed Order with IDEM.
