Again on this encroachment. I do not recommend allowing a structure in the easement.

First and foremost, we do not allow structures in the easement. Second, a structure would inhibit the ability to maintain that pond and force the maintenance crews on the slopes of the pond which are unsafe during wet weather. It may also force maintenance crews into the high water during storm events.
