Mayor and Board Members,

The construction area for the WWTP Improvements Project is the current location of the brush and leaf drop off area for City Departments and City residents. Our current schedule for construction activities has the excavation work commencing in early February. Due to the extent of the excavation, around 30 feet deep, it is not feasible to be able to keep this area open to the public during construction.

At this time, I am requesting that this area be closed to the public effective January 1, 2021, and for it to remain closed until further notice. While we realize that this will be an inconvenience to those who use this City provided service, it is just not possible to ensure the safety of the public in this area once the construction activities begin. Proper signage will be posted as soon as possible in order to provide ample notice to those who use this area on a routine basis. Please let me know if any other information is needed or if there are any questions regarding this request.
