Councilman Pendlum led the invocation followed by all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilman Lowder.

CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

Mayor Chuck Fewell called the meeting to order of the Common Council for the purpose of conducting the business before the Greenfield Common Council.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion to approve the June 13, 2018 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Riley and duly seconded by Councilman Grass. Motion carried *viva voce*.

REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMISSIONS:

Councilman Skvarenina provided an update on Elizabeth Ann Kitchen and to date funds raised are \$123,600.00.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2018 – 10 An Ordinance Authorizing Additional Appropriations for the Police Department for the expenses needed for repairs on the citywide Weather Warning Sirens; on second reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-10 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Skvarenina. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Ordinance 2018 – 10 An Ordinance Authorizing Additional Appropriations for the Police Department for the expenses needed for repairs on the citywide Weather Warning Sirens; on third and final reading and eligible for adoption. Councilman Skvarenina motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-10 as presented on third reading, seconded by Councilman Riley. Mayor Fewell called for a roll call vote by Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Walter. AYES: Councilman Pendlum, Riley, Skvarenina, Butrum and Grass. Naves: None. Ordinance 2018-10 was declared approved by 6 to 0 vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2018 – 11 An Ordinance Regulating Traffic and Providing Penalties for Violation thereof; on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock for the Common Council. Councilman Lowder motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-11 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Skvarenina. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Skip Kuker, Director of the Hancock Economic Development Council came forward to update Form CF-1 information for BWI Indiana Inc. and Pure Development. BWI requested no action be taken at this time. City Attorney Morelock suggested withdrawing Form CF-1. Councilman Riley motioned to approve request to withdraw, seconded by Councilman Lowder. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Mayor Fewell announced that Dan Worl and Jane Webb would not be presenting as was stated on the agenda. They will be rescheduling for another Council meeting in the future.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:

Jason Davis, General President of Hancock County Professional Fire Fighters came forward to present to the council his presentation in regards to adding on more firemen to Greenfield. He requested an 11% tax referendum in order to increase funding for the Fire Department. Discussion followed.

ADJOURNMENT:

Mayor Fewell moved that there being no further business to be brought before the Greenfield Common Council, Councilman Grass moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:34 p.m., duly seconded by Councilman Lowder. Motion carried *viva voce*.
