

ORDINANCE 2021 – 19

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE
LOCAL OPTION INCOME TAX FUND**

WHEREAS, the City of Greenfield, in Section 30.20 of the Code of Ordinance, created a Local Option Income Tax Fund (“LOIT FUND”); and

WHEREAS, the utilization of the LOIT FUND shall be for public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed for the purchase of police vehicles, associated equipment and miscellaneous required items for the Greenfield Police Department and for the purchase of vehicles and a traffic control system required by the Greenfield Fire Territory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENFIELD, INDIANA:

SECTION I

That for the expenses of said City of Greenfield, Indiana, the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated from the LOIT Public Safety Fund Account #225:
