Re: Design PSA with American Structurepoint, Inc. – Davis Road Regional Pump Station

Mayor and Board Members,

In April 2022, we engaged American Structurepoint to prepare a Preliminary Engineering Report in SRF format for the Waterview lift station and a proposed Davis Road lift station. We are now ready to proceed with the full design on the Davis Road Regional Pump Station and the initial phase of a Davis Road interceptor. This initial phase of this project includes a regional pump station located near the entrance to the WWTP capable of pumping up to 2500 GPM, a gravity sewer extending east to the proposed round-a-bout at Morristown Pike and Davis Road, the ability to extend a future gravity sewer west along Davis Road, and a gravity sewer extending south of Davis Road to intercept the flows entering the Chapman Estates Lift Station and abandon the existing lift station and force main.

At this time, I am requesting that the Board approve the Professional Services Agreement with American Structurepoint, Inc. in the amount of \$194,250.00 for design services related to the Davis Road Regional Pump Station Project. A copy of the PSA has been included for your review. Please let me know if there are any questions or if any other information is needed at this time.
