

ORDINANCE NO. 2024/12

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF GREENFIELD, INDIANA WITH THE ADDITION OF § 30.53

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana has heretofore created a Nonreverting State Seizure Fund denominated as the “Homeland Security Investigation Fund” and designated as Fund #2427 into which all seizure funds received from the Department of Treasury Equitable Sharing Program are to be deposited; and

WHEREAS, as determined by a recent audit, payment from Fund #2427 may not be made to compensate officers involved in the program for hours of overtime worked; and

WHEREAS, at the suggestion of the Auditors and the Clerk-Treasurer, the creation of a new Nonreverting Fund designated as the Homeland Security-Overtime Nonreverting Fund designated as Fund #2424 is required to be created in order to make earned overtime payments to applicable officers; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana, believes the creation of said Nonreverting Fund as recommended by the Auditors and the Clerk-Treasurer is in the best interest of the citizens of Greenfield, Indiana and the efficient management of the monies received by and through the Homeland Security Investigation Fund.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana that:

SECTION I

Title III, Chapter 30 shall be amended by the addition of § 30.53 entitled Homeland Security-Overtime Nonreverting Fund and commonly referred to as Fund #2424 to be worded as follows:

§ 30.53 Homeland Security-Overtime Nonreverting Fund. There is hereby established a special Nonreverting Fund known as the Homeland Security-Overtime Nonreverting Fund referenced as Fund #2424. Initial contributions to said fund shall be made from the Local Option Income Tax Public Safety Fund #2240 in the amount of \$10,000.00. Thereafter the sole source of monetary contributions shall be overtime payments received from the Department of Treasury. Said funds may only be expended in order to make earned overtime payments to applicable officers.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and publication as prescribed by law.
